

Involvement of key partners from public, private and non-profit sector

Search for consensus among main actors and investors on strategic interventions

Strategic management on the city level

Pressure on overall project quality and delivery of RESULTS

Integrated approach in planning (mobility-environment, education-training-job market, etc.)











5 principles:


- Strategic and integrated approach to urban development
- 2) Polycentric development of settlement system
- 3) Support of cities as poles of territorial development
- 4) Care for the urban environment
- Implementation of New Urban Agenda (in response to the emerging documents at the UN level)



Role of Housing in Urban Development

- 1) Part of the holistic approach "Quality of life"
- Livable cities have to reflect demands of local people we can not reach sustainability without participation
- Housing is seen as an important element of urban ecosystem (housing – mobility – public service – local economy linkages)
- 4) Affordable housing should be the key principle for strategic planning (SDG 11)
