




- important portion in housing stock:

in Prague nearly 1/2




- variety of urban arrangements and sizes

- shift in the social perception








a/ inherent deficiencies



> discrepancy between urban structure and infrastructural systems



> reduced ability to accommodate variety of activities within the neighbourhoods




