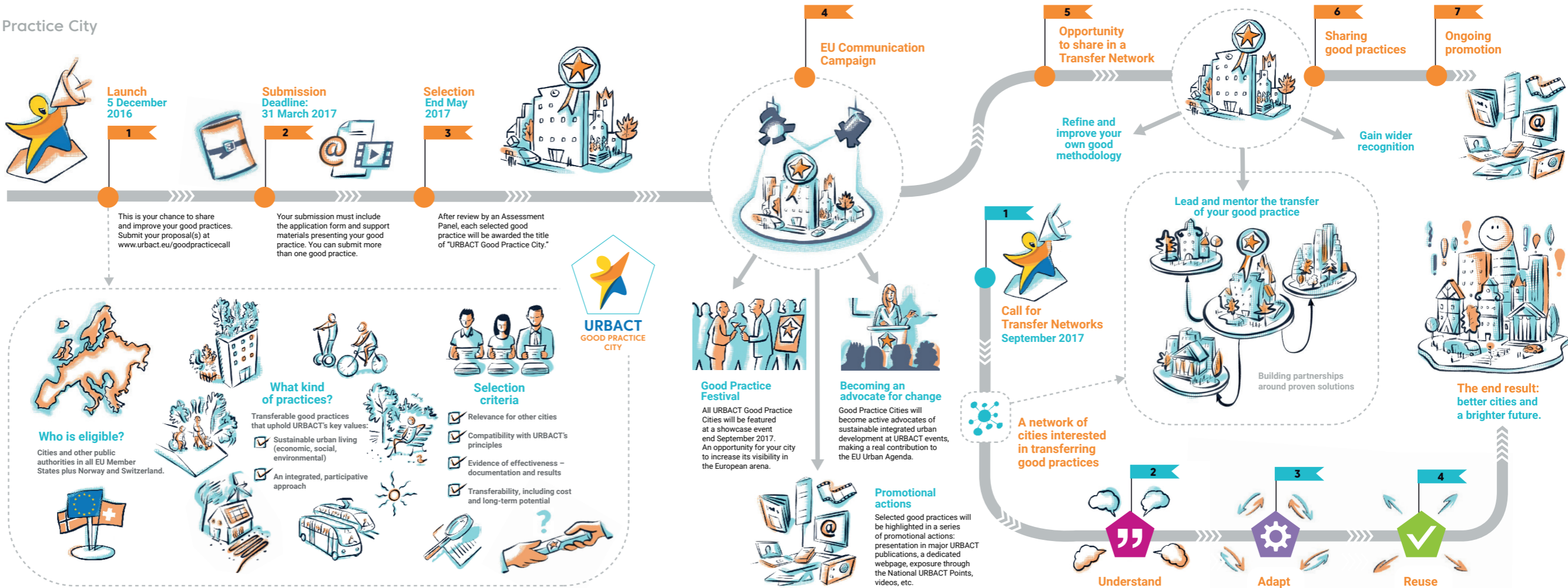
## Meeting Europe's urban challenges together

### Who is eligible?

Cities and other public authorities in all EU Member States plus Norway and Switzerland.

### What kind of practices?

Transferable good practices that uphold URBACT's key values:

- Sustainable urban living (economic, social, environmental)
- An integrated, participative approach

### Selection criteria

- Relevance for other cities
- Compatibility with URBACT's principles
- Evidence of effectiveness – documentation and results
- Transferability, including cost and long-term potential



### Good Practice Festival

All URBACT Good Practice Cities will be featured at a showcase event end September 2017. An opportunity for your city to increase its visibility in the European arena.

### Becoming an advocate for change

Good Practice Cities will become active advocates of sustainable integrated urban development at URBACT events, making a real contribution to the EU Urban Agenda.

Selected good practices will be highlighted in a series of promotional actions: presentation in major URBACT publications, a dedicated webpage, exposure through the National URBACT Points, videos, etc.
