Martina Postupová graduated from the Faculty of Law at Masaryk University in Brno. She has spent her entire professional career in various public administration institutions. Probably the most significant part of her career has been connected with law and the Ministry of the Interior, where, after her studies, she started as an administrative and self-government officer in the Department of Legislation and Coordination of Regulations. Since November 2011, she has served as a member of the Commission for the Reform of Administrative Proceedings and Administrative Punishment. In January 2018, she became a member of the Advisory Board to the Deputy Minister of the Interior for Civil Service. From December 2020, she held the position of HR Director of the Civil Service Section. Since April 2024, she has been the State Secretary at the Ministry for Regional Development.

Martina Postupová is a member of several review commissions, where she works alongside other administrative law experts in discussing cases and formulating recommendations for the minister's decisions. In recent years, she has focused mainly on personnel policy issues in public administration.



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
