

## Martin Pělucha

Martin Pělucha is a professor in the field of economic policy at the University of Economics in Prague and has also been active as an expert in evaluations since 2003 at the company IREAS. Throughout his career, he has served as coordinator or member of numerous research projects related to the evaluation of public expenditure programs funded by both national and European sources (carried out for Czech Science Foundation, Technology Agency of the Czech Republic, the European Commission, the Ministry of Agriculture, the Ministry of Regional Development of the Czech Republic, the Ministry of Environment of the Czech Republic, regional authorities of Czech coal regions, etc.). In his publishing activities, he focuses mainly on regional policy, with a specific emphasis on critically analysing the role of rural development policy within the EU's Common Agricultural Policy. Prof. Martin Pělucha is the national ambassador of the RSA – Regional Studies Association in the Czech Republic and is also a member of the Czech Evaluation Society. At the same time, he participates in several governmental and ministerial working groups (e.g., the Socioeconomic Committee of the Government Council for Sustainable Development; Ministry of Regional Development – Working Group for Rural Areas).
